About the ACCF

Inception date	2014 Bilateral Trust fund later converted to a Multi-donor Trust fund in 2017
Trust Fund Size	\$25.71 million
Areas of Intervention	Climate finance readiness and preparatory activities; Preparation and financing of adaptation and mitigation projects and strategies in the context of the NDCs; Institutional capacity building; Gender equality and climate resilience
Modalities for accessing funds	Calls for Proposals and Demand Driven Window
Financial Instruments	Small Grants
Min/max Grant size	\$250k to \$1million per grant
Eligible Beneficiaries	AfDB Regional Member countries, NGOs, Regional Institutions, African Funds, Research institutions

Objectives of the ACCF

Provides small grants to support African countries in their transition to climate resilient and low carbon development aligned to Nationally Determined Contributions.



Building capacity of African stakeholders on climate change, scaling up access to climate finance



Supporting RMCs to integrate climate change and green growth into national strategies and policies



Co-financing projects and programs to advance climate resilient and low carbon development



Contributing to the implementation of the Bank's Climate Change & Green Growth Strategic Framework

Areas of interventions/ windows

A. Supporting direct access to climate finance

- Development of bankable projects aligned to African countries NDCs/NAPs
- Supporting the identification and strengthening of national institutions to access the GCF/AF/GEF

B. Supporting small scale or pilot adaptation initiatives to build resilience of vulnerable communities

- Promoting access to clean energy, climate-resilient agriculture and economic diversification
- Creating opportunities for youth and women in low-carbon sectors and improving access to WASH

Calls for Proposals (CFP 1 & 2) Demand Driven Window

- Land restoration in collaboration with farmers especially in the Sahel; and
- Support to the development and implementation of NDCs and LTS
- Electrification of health centers in rural areas using renewable energy and energy storage technologies;
- Low carbon management of medical and sanitary waste including hazardous waste incineration.

Supporting mechanisms for climate finance that are adapted and accessible directly to women and women's groups

Supporting increased participation, leadership, and influence of women and women's groups in community- level, national and international climate change negotiations

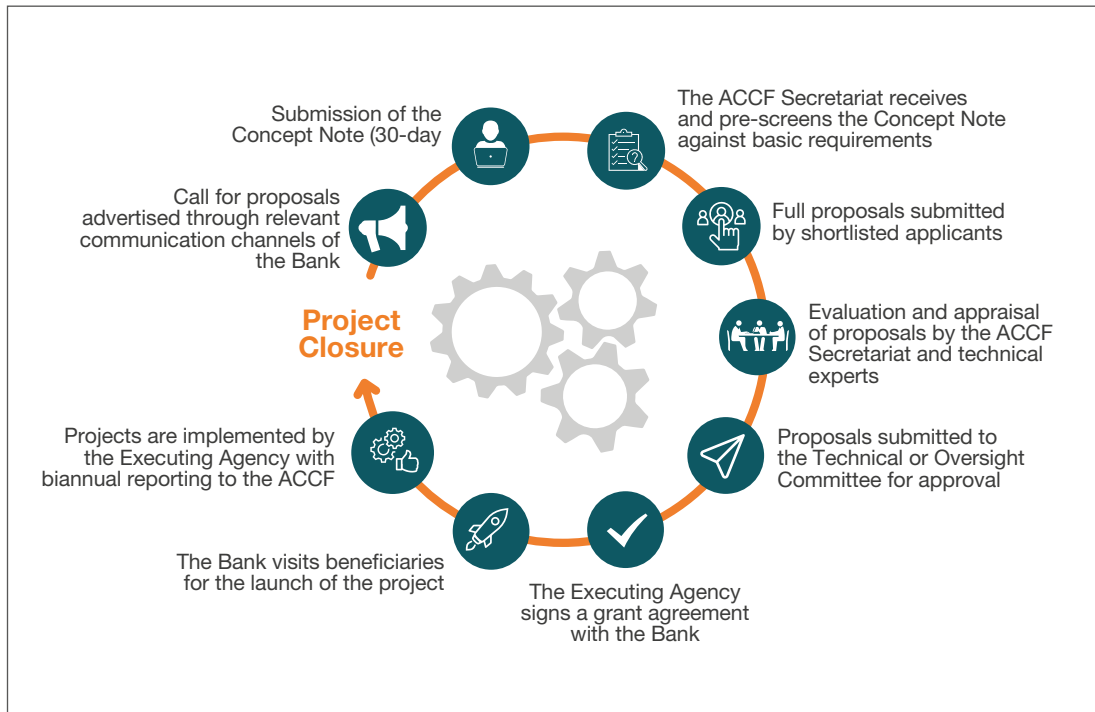
Gender Equality & Climate Resilience (CFP3)

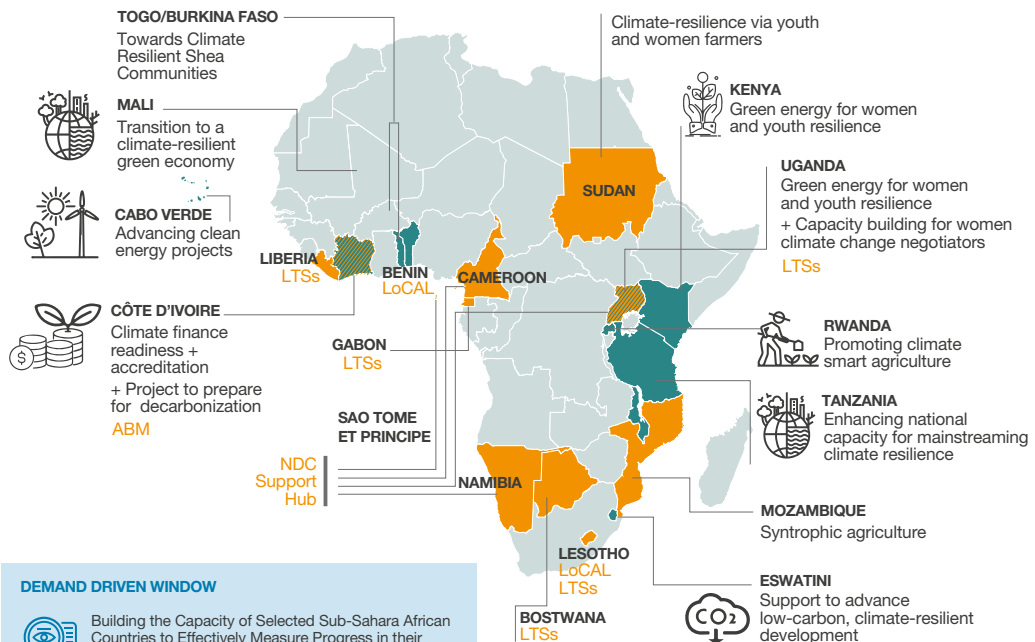

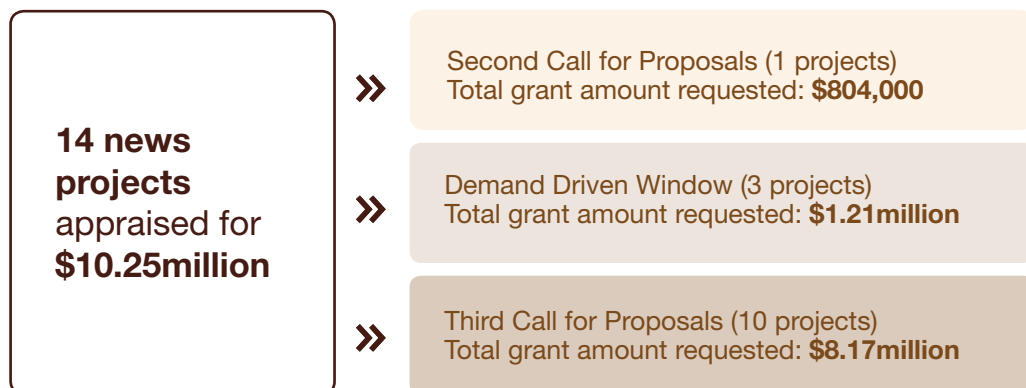
